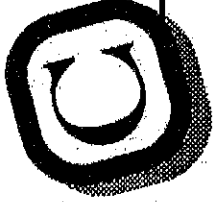
Children who are currently enrolled at St. David's and their siblings have already registered. Due to these registrations, we have limited spaces available for those who have been waiting to apply. In order to be fair to everyone involved, we will begin processing applications on Wednesday, February 2. If we receive more applications than the number of spaces available, it will be necessary to use a lottery system assigning everyone a number and then drawing numbers to assign spaces.

Please return your registration form with the \$75 registration fee no later than February 1. You will be notified by mid-February and at that time we will let you know if we have a space for your child or if your child is on the waiting list. We will be offering a tour at 10:00 on Tuesday, March 1 for anyone who has not yet seen the school.

CLASSES OFFERED

2's & 2 1/2's

Children range in age from 18-months by Sept. 1 to age 3 and are placed in age appropriate groups. Teacher / pupil ratios range from 1:4 to 1:5. Classes meet on MWF or T & Th from 9 to 11:40 a.m. The program consists of varied and enriched experiences to provide for the very young child's optimal growth socially, emotionally, physically and cognitively in a nurturing environment.

3's

Children are 3 by Sept. 1. Teacher / pupil ratios range from 1:7 to 1:8. Classes meet on MWF or M-F from 9 to 11:45 a.m. The program consists of developmentally appropriate activities and play experiences that aid cognitive and language development.

Yng. 4's

Children are 3 years 7 mos. by Sept. 1. Teacher / pupil ratios range from 1:7 to 1:8. Classes meet on TWTu or M-F from 9 to 11:45 a.m. The program consists of a relaxed approach to readiness activities for the child who may need an additional Pre-K year due to his/her birth date. Emphasis is on creative and imaginative experiences.

4's & Pre-K's

Children are 4 by Sept. 1. Teacher/pupil ratios range from 1:7 to 1:8. Classes meet on M-F from 9 to 11:50 a.m. The program emphasizes Kindergarten readiness skills using various games, stories, and hands-on activities. There are opportunities to make choices and participate in large and small group activities while developing language arts, math, and writing skills.

Junior Kindergarten

Children are 5 by Jan 1. Teacher/pupil ratio is 1:7 or 1:8. Classes meet on M-F from 9 to 11:50 a.m. The program emphasizes Kindergarten readiness skills with an emphasis on literature and math. Children have the opportunity to participate in large and small group activities while developing language arts, math and writing skills. Students have option of signing up for Jr. K-Enrichment should a longer day be preferred.

Kindergarten

Children are 5 by Sept. 1. Teacher / pupil ratio is 1:8. Classes meet M&F from 9 to 1:00 p.m. and TWTu from 9 to 3:00 p.m. See curriculum information.

Junior Enrichment

For children enrolled in the 5 Day 3's and Young 4's classes. Teacher/pupil ratios range from 1:7 to 1:8. Classes meet from 1 to 3:00 p.m. on TWTu. The optional program offers an extended day option with enrichment opportunities including Cook and Book, Story Time Fun, Jr. STEM, Spanish, Yoga and Computer/iPad activities for children who are enrolled in the morning 5 day 3's and Young 4's classes.

Pre-K/Jr. K Enrichment

For children in the 4's, Pre-K and Junior Kindergarten classes. Teacher/pupil ratios range from 1:7 to 1:8. Classes meet from 1 to 3:00 p.m. on TWTu. The optional program offers an extended day option with enrichment opportunities including Cooking, Music, Fundations Wilson Language training, STEM, Spanish, Yoga and Smart Board/iPad activities for children who are enrolled in the morning 4's, Pre-K and Junior kindergarten classes.



KINDERGARTEN

St. David's Nursery School's Kindergarten Program is offered for children who are 5 by September 1st. The program is from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. on Monday and Friday and from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday and offers a wide variety of readiness activities preparing children for first grade. The school's developmentally appropriate, multisensory, nurturing philosophy is continued in the Kindergarten program.

Kindergarten Goals

1. To recognize that all children have individual learning styles, strengths and needs.
2. To help each child develop physically, socially, emotionally, and intellectually by providing opportunities for perceiving, manipulating, and interacting with people and objects.
3. To give each child the opportunity to develop through his/her natural way of exploring, playing and learning. Emphasis is placed on creative thinking, reasoning, skill development, problem solving, and decision making.
4. To acquaint each child with his/her environment through a first-hand multi-sensory approach.
5. To develop communication skills for learning and relating to others.
6. To help each child develop independence as well as the ability to function successfully as a group member.
7. To develop self-expression through experiences in art, music, creative movement, and drama.
8. To develop the child's curiosity and initiative to discover, experiment, and acquire information about his/her world.
